It was not long before the Gingerbread man came across a horse. "Stop, little man! I want to eat you!", the horse said, but the Gingerbread man outran him too.

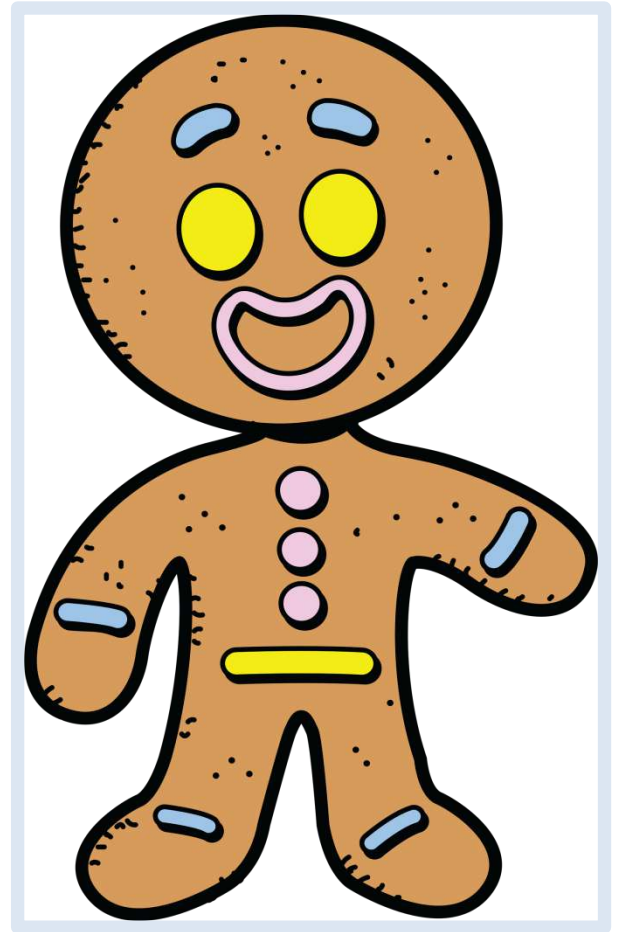
